The overall aim of this thesis is to examine the impact of the conflict in Yemen on women's employment. It uses two national representative household surveys collected before and after the conflict and use a quantitative empirical methodology (difference-in-differences) to identify the causal effects.

The thesis is very well structured as it starts with a clear introduction that states the problem addressed in the study; it provides a general background of conflicts in low-income countries and of women's economic empowerment in Yemen. It then includes a theoretical framework followed by a background of the conflict in Yemen. Chapter IV describes the conflict in Yemen. The following chapters describe the data used, the variables of interest, the empirical methodology and the empirical results. The quality and depth of the analysis is also very high.
