NATURALLY, STUDENT PAID ADEQUATE ATTENTION TO DEFINITION OF AND EXPLANATION OF THE GIST OF THE RIGHT TO BE FORGOTTEN. HE THEN FORMULATED AND SUMMARIZED HIS CONCLUSIONS.

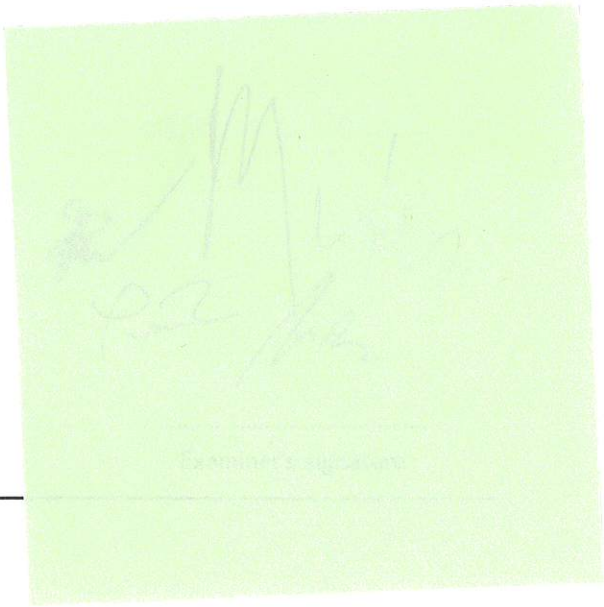

AMONG ELSE, HE MENTIONED AND ADDRESSED CHALLENGES ON APPLICATION OF THIS RIGHT VIS-A-VIS WIDE USAGE OF THE AI (E.G. IN RELATION TO USAGE OF DEEP FAKES). HE ALSO RESPONDED TO OBSTACLES CONCERNING EXERCISE OF JURISDICTION IN THE SPHERE OF INTERNET.

DURING THE DEFENCE, MR. KOCHARTAN PROVED HIGH LEVEL OF PROFICIENCY IN HIS RESPONSES. HE SWIFTLY REACTED TO ALL QUESTIONS PRESENTED DURING THE SESSION.
