Final appreciation (global view): note A

Kateřina Procházková's work is quite satisfactory. Serious student, stubborn, willful, she choses difficult subject to deal with; difficults for two main reasons:

1 / the terrain is very difficult to access. Dominica is an island enclave, accessible only by boat, only on certain days of the week. Fortunately, Kateřina Procházková has managed remarkably research in the field.

2 / there is almost no work on this island. Certainly, there is research on the island, ecotourism, eco-tourism in the islands, the islands best known and most easily accessible as the French West Indies, Barbados, etc. But on the Dominque' Island, there are very few studies. And these studies are currently very superficial.

Conditions of the departures were very difficult and the result is very nice. In a very short time, she was able to collect data essential to meet the key players in the tourism. I would like to congratulate her on her ability to work, her analytical skills, her remarkable adaptation (by crop and by language).

Analysis of the work: note A.

The candidate had to collect all of the data extremely difficult to obtain. She has the intelligence used to restructure and consolidate the analysis accurately. Its bibliographic work is quite honest. All references to databases are integrated into her work.

Work very encouraging for further studies. It will need to develop these personal cards (this is the weak point of work - and this weakness is secondary to all the work she has done).
